

Since the announcement of Midstate closing at the end of the summer term, many of you have reached out about the next steps to take to complete your degree. An Articulation/Teach Out Agreement between Midstate College and Lincoln College has been reached to facilitate the ease of transfer and degree completion of Midstate College students in the Bachelor of Business Administration degree for baccalaureate completion at Lincoln College through the Bachelor of Business Administration in Business Management program.

Lincoln College's [Accelerated Bridge to Education](#) (ABE Program) offers evening hybrid 5-week courses that meet one night a week and online **at ICC's Peoria Campus**.

The administration at Lincoln College is ready to help you with the opportunity to finish your degree. To learn more about this agreement and the Lincoln College ABE Program, there will be an [ABE Transfer Night](#) for Midstate Students on **Thursday, August 8 from 5:30 – 7:00**. The location of the transfer night is Arbor Hall Room A-004 at [ICC's Peoria Campus at 5407 N. University St. in Peoria](#). (See the [ICC Peoria Campus map](#) for parking options.) If you plan to attend the transfer night, it would be a good idea to bring an unofficial transcript as advisors will be on hand to discuss transfer courses along with Admissions Counselors.

Highlights of the agreement are as follows:

- Students can take a 3 credit course each 5 weeks for 9 credits per semester in this year-round program (up to 27 credits in a year). The first 5-week fall session begins the week of August 19. The next 5-week session begins the week of September 23.
- Tuition is \$330 per semester hour with no [application](#) fee. A limited number of [RLI Peoria scholarships](#) are available each semester. The Lincoln College FAFSA code is 001709.
- Lincoln College will waive the \$50 confirmation deposit for Midstate College students admitted for this fall semester.
- Students enrolled at Midstate spring or summer of 2019 will have the 30 credit residency requirement waived if transferring into the [Bachelor of Business Administration in Business Management](#).

Other degree options through Lincoln College include a [Bachelor of Arts in Organizational Leadership](#) and a [Bachelor of Science in Health Services Administration](#).

Lincoln College has also announced the start of two graduate degrees: a Masters of Business Administration (MBA) and a Master of Science in Organizational Leadership (MS ORL).
